English	<p>Writing: The children will be writing a biography about Shakleton and an information text about penguins.</p> <p>Reading: The children will be reading Charlie and the Chocolate Factory by Roald Dahl.</p>	Mathematics	<p>To identify horizontal and vertical lines and parts of perpendicular and parallel lines. Draw 2d shapes and make 3d shapes using modelling materials. Recognise 3d shapes in different orientations and describe them. Interpret and present data using bar charts, pictograms and tables. To read time on an analogue clock to the nearest minute.</p>
Geography	<p>Who lives in Antarctica? Learning about latitude and longitude, pupils consider how this links to climate. Pupils contemplate the tilt of the Earth and how this impacts the Antarctic circle and global temperatures. They explore the physical features of a polar region and how humans have adapted to working there.</p>	Science	<p>Does hand span affect grip strength? Experimenting, analysing data and drawing conclusions allows children to explore the relationship between hand span and grip strength. They test different gloves to improve grip strength and apply their newfound knowledge to design friction gloves, fostering scientific inquiry and problem-solving skills.</p>
Art/DT	<p>Design and make Egyptian Collars. Learning how to cross-stitch and appliqué to decorate and assemble Egyptian collars, which represent the children's unique personalities.</p>	Computing	<p>Events and actions in Programs Children will explore the links between events and actions, while consolidating prior learning relating to sequencing.</p>
RE	<p>The children will be learning about what it means to show courage and looking at examples from different religions. They will also study Martin Luther King and Hany El-Banna and how they made a difference in the world.</p>	PSHE	<p>Children will learn how to keep safe around water and roads as well as what to do in a fire. We will also discuss transition into Year 4</p>
PE	<p>Athletics Children will control movement in response to instructions, demonstrate agility and speed, jump for height and distance and throw with speed and power.</p> <p>Rounders</p>	Spanish	<p>Learning about the names of objects in your home like kitchen, sofa and living room.</p>
