<b>English</b>	Writing: The children will be looking at the discovery of Tutankhamun and writing a newspaper report about this.	<b>Mathematics</b>	<b>Fractions</b> -Add and subtract -Partition the whole -Unit fractions of a set of objects -Fractions of amounts <b>Money</b> -convert pounds and pence -add and subject money -find change
<b>History</b>	<b>What did Ancient Egyptians believe?</b> Developing awareness of how historians learn about the past using mummies, the Book of the Dead and pyramids, children learn the place of the ancient Egyptians in time. Pupils learn about the importance of religion in the ancient Egyptians' lives and consider how this is evident in pyramids, worship and mummification.	<b>Science</b>	<b>Plant Reproduction</b> Building on their prior knowledge of plant structures, children describe the functions of named parts and use evidence to explain their significance in plant development. Pupils investigate factors that may affect plant growth and how water is transported.
<b>Art</b>	The children will be looking at botanical artwork with a focus on Van Gogh. The children will recreate his famous sunflower painting.	<b>Computing</b>	<b>Programming</b> The children will use the programming software Scratch to sequence sounds, events and actions.
<b>RE</b>	The children will be learning about the importance of being open, honest and truthful.	<b>PSHE</b>	Children will learn how to keep their bodies healthy including eating a balanced diet and their feelings.
<b>PE</b>	<b>Cricket</b> Children will learn to adhere to some of the basic rules of cricket. Develop a range of skills to use in isolation and competitive context. They will also strike a bowled ball.	<b>Spanish</b>	Learn names for different types of clothing.
