<b>English</b>	<p><b>Writing:</b> The children will be writing a biography all about Charles Darwin who will be our scientist focus this half-term. After that, the children will be creating a suspenseful story.</p> <p><b>Reading:</b> Darwin's Dragons by Lindsey Galvin.</p>	<b>Mathematics</b>	<p>The children will be covering the following topics:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-Ratio</li> <li>-Algebra</li> <li>-Decimals</li> </ul>
<b>Geography</b>	<p><b>Why does the population change?</b> Looking at global population distribution, children think about why certain areas are more populated than others. They explore the factors that influence birth and death rates and use case studies to illustrate these. Children consider and discuss the social, economic and environmental push and pull factors that influence migration.</p>	<b>Science</b>	<p><b>Evolution and Inheritance</b> Studying patterns in humans and other species, children learn about characteristics that are inherited from parents and those that are environmental. Through the eyes of Darwin and Wallace, pupils understand how observations lead to theories and explore natural selection.</p>
<b>Art</b>	<p>The children will be using oil pastels to draw their very own dragon eye. Using these as inspiration, they will then create their eyes using clay.</p>	<b>Computing</b>	<p><b>Webpage Creation</b> The children will be introduced to creating a website using google slides. Throughout the process, we will be focusing on copyright and fair use of media.</p>
<b>RE</b>	<p>The children will be looking at the dispositions, remembering roots and being confident and courageous.</p>	<b>PSHE</b>	<p>Children will look at how they are part of a community and the diversity within our communities. The children will look at safety and usage of the internet as well as what to believe or not to believe.</p>
<b>PE</b>	<p><b>Netball</b> Children are to choose and implement a range of strategies to attack and defend. They will perform a wider range of more complex skills and recognise and describe good performances.</p>	<b>Spanish</b>	<p>We will be learning about clothes. Within this topic, we will be using our knowledge of colours and which clothes we might wear in different seasons.</p>
