English	<p>Writing: The children will be writing instructions on how to get rid of witches. They will be writing a fantasy story about an encounter with a witch.</p>	Mathematics	<p>The children will be learning to: -Add and subtract fractions beyond a whole number. -Work with mixed numbers and improper fractions and convert between the two Group fractions into families. -Understand tenths and hundredths -Divide by 10 and 100</p>
Geography	<p><u>What are in rivers and how are they used?</u> Exploring the different ways water is stored and moves, pupils develop an understanding of the water cycle. They name and map major rivers both in the UK and globally. Children learn about the features and courses of a river and how they are used by humans, before studying a local river to spot these features.</p>	Science	<p><u>Sounds and Vibrations</u> Exploring different ways of producing sounds, children learn about the relationship between vibrations and what they hear. They study dolphins and whales to develop their understanding of how sound travels between objects and investigate the role of insulation to protect our ears.</p>
Art/DT	<p><u>ART</u> The children will be completing an artist study on Claude Monet and learning how to use acrylic paints. They will recreate a piece of his artwork.</p>	Computing	<p><u>Data Logging</u> The children will be using data loggers. Understand why data is collected and pose questions about what the data shows us. E-Safety will continue to learn about the importance of keeping passwords and usernames private. Also, what they can/can't upload to social media.</p>
RE	<p>In RE the children will be learning about mercy and forgiveness.</p>	PSHE	<p>Children will learn about money and how to make money. They will understand the difference between debit and credit and what budgeting is.</p>
PE	<p><u>Netball</u></p>	Spanish	<p>Children will be revising previous learning. They will be learning new vocabulary for fruit.</p>

	<p>We will introduce high five netball positions. Children will acquire and apply basic shooting techniques. They will demonstrate and implement some basic rules of high five netball. They will develop netball skills such as marking and footwork and be introduced to the concept of preliminary moves.</p> <p><u>Gymnastics</u></p> <p>Children will become increasingly confident and competent to perform skills more consistently.
