English	<p>Writing: The children will be creating a non-chronological report about an animal that survives in the rainforest. The children will be using the book, There's a Rang-Tan in My Bedroom, to discuss the effects of palm oil and deforestation.</p>	Mathematics	<p>Decimal Numbers</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -make whole numbers with tenths and hundredths -order, compare and partition decimals -round to the nearest whole number -halves and quarters as decimals <p>Money</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -write money using decimals -convert between pounds and pence -compare, estimate and calculate with money -solve problems with money
Geography	<p>Why are rainforests important to us?</p> <p>Focussing on the link between biomes and climate, children will locate the Amazon rainforest and explain how the vegetation in a tropical rainforest is defined by the two Tropics. They investigate the physical features and layers of the Amazon rainforest, considering how plants adapt to these conditions.</p>	Science	<p>Classification and Changing Habitats</p> <p>Identifying different ways to group living things, children make classification keys to explore which grouping methods are most effective. Pupils study ways habitats change over time and understand that humans can have both positive and negative effects on their surroundings.</p>
Art	<p>The children will be looking</p>	Computing	<p>Programming</p> <p>In coding the children will learn how to use repetition and loops using scratch.</p>
