Warm weather clothing for Forest School

Our policy states that

In warm dry weather, children could have:-

- Jogging Bottoms/Tracksuit trousers (not jeans)
- T-shirt or (preferably) long sleeved t-shirt
- Sweatshirt
- Sun hat

This has been to minimise risk of stings and bites and increase protection from the sun.

We recognise that there are now longer and warmer periods during which children will attend Forest School and that the School allows t-shirts and shorts to be worn at this time.

To minimise conflict for the children and balance the risk to children during these periods the following is suggested:-

We will work on the basis that children do not have sun protection.

Boots will still need to be worn.

Time in the sunshine will be limited during the afternoon (UVI levels to determine length of time). At other times, activities will be confined to base or shady areas.

Game will not involve hiding on site due to the increased risk of stings and bites.

This protocol will be reviewed regularly and changed as deemed necessary.
